PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS, historic military vehicles rekindle memories for those that served our great country in peace and conflict, a common bond for veterans of all eras; and,
- WHEREAS, many of these military vehicles represent the American motor vehicle industry's finest and most durable products, made here and built to take the rigors and punishment of any environment in the world; and
- WHEREAS, those that restore these vehicles do so with great attention to detail, respect, and devotion, often refurbishing parts no longer produced by resurrecting old skills and craftsmanship; and
- WHEREAS, those that maintain these retired vehicles often display them at patriotic events, ceremonies, and parades that afford the Indiana public an opportunity to experience and appreciate them as well; and
- WHEREAS, it is appropriate to recognize historic military vehicles and those that restore, maintain, and display an essential component of Indiana's rich military heritage;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mitchell E. Daniels, Jr., Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim September 13-19, 2010 as

HISTORIC MILITARY VEHICLE PRESERVATION WEEK

in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
