Re: Military Registrations/Registration Fee Waiver

As you are aware, owners of antique military vehicles may display their military registration numbers on their vehicle instead of a license plate. In order to collect the County Taxes and insure that these owners & vehicles are on our registration database, we require the owners to register the vehicles with an antique plate. A hand-typed registration with the military registration number is also issued when the vehicle is initially registered.

It has come to our attention that these owners are NOT required to pay the \$20.75 antique registration fee.

If you have a customer with an antique military vehicle, you will continue to register the vehicle with an Antique plate. If the transaction is run on BOSS, you will charge the customer the appropriate County Taxes (\$12.00 excise and applicable Surtax) and fee waiver the \$20.75 registration fee. If the transaction is run on STARS, you will "Waive Specific Fee" while you are processing the transaction.

Please continue to communicate to the owner that displaying the antique plate while traveling out of state is recommended.

Military Vehicle Registration

IC 9-18-14

Chapter 14. Military Vehicle Registration

IC 9-18-14-1

Alternative registration

Sec. 1. A person who owns a military vehicle may register the military vehicle under this chapter instead of registering for a license plate issued for:

(1) a vehicle under IC 9-18-2; or

(2) an antique motor vehicle under IC 9-18-12.

IC 9-18-14-2

Permanent registration

Sec. 2. If a person who owns a military vehicle registers the military vehicle under this chapter, the registration of the military vehicle is for the life of the military vehicle.

IC 9-18-14-3

Registration number; no plate issued

Sec. 3. If a person who owns a military vehicle registers the military vehicle under this chapter the:

(1) bureau shall not issue a license plate for the military vehicle; and

(2) bureau shall authorize as a registration number the military vehicle identification number stenciled on the military vehicle in white or yellow letters and numbers in accordance with all pertinent military regulations. As added by P.L.2-1991, SEC.6.

IC 9-18-14-4

Registration form and certificates

Sec. 4. The bureau shall adopt a:

- (1) registration form; and
- (2) certificate of registration;

to implement this chapter.

IC 9-18-14-5

Rules

Sec. 5. The bureau shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to implement this chapter.

IC 9-13-2-103

Military vehicle

Sec. 103. "Military vehicle" means a vehicle that:

- (1) was originally manufactured for military use;
- (2) is motorized or nonmotorized, including a motorcycle, motor scooter, and trailer;
- (3) is at least twenty-five (25) years old; and
- (4) is privately owned.
